ES FLOG EIN KLEINS WALDVÖGLEIN ("There flew a little forest bird") is a 17th century German folk song that was first used as a hymn tune for "O Day of Rest and Gladness"; amongst its other hymn settings is #733 in our hymnals, "We All Are One in Mission," tying in with the theme of today's service.

As Martin Luther King Jr. Day is tomorrow (January 20), we honor his legacy with the great anthem "Lift Every Voice and Sing" as our postlude. Love and unity are not just states of being, they are actions, and this song reminds us that we cannot rest on our past laurels—especially in the face of present dangers—, that we must "sing, till earth and heaven ring...with the harmonies of liberty," and to "march on, till victory is won."
